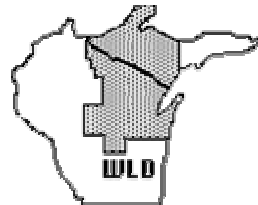

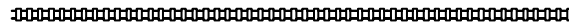
Featuring our Modular Layout!
